I got a call from **208-269-2067**, they left a voicemail. I called back and they informed me I missed a jury summons on May 10 and had two citations, one for failure to appear and another for contempt of court, each with \$750 fee. They had our old address they said it was mailed to which I haven't updated yet. To clear this, I had to do 1-2 things:

- 1- community service...
- 2- pay the fees, speak with **Judge Dane Watkins** via teleconference, the fees would just be held and returned to me.

I didn't recognize the number and it sounded like a scam. They reassured me this was on a recorded line, they asked if I wanted to be called back from the **Bonneville County Sheriff's office** directly, I said yes. I received a call right back from **208-529-1200**. **They gave me a few options to pay-come in for payment vouchers (?), Venmo, Apple Pay iOS.** I paid \$1550 Venmo as shown. It sounded like this was not a state citation but a federal and they attempted to get more money and I hung up. They attempted to call back, but I stopped it there. I called the bank, and they blocked the Venmo transaction, and it should not go through.

I talked to several different men, no accents but fast/confusing speech, with law enforcement jargon. I didn't give (nor did they ask for) any personal information except my full name. They knew my prior address. They said because I had no other previous trouble with the law these options were available.
