Any party deciding to proceed before a United States Magistrate Judge should sign the consent to proceed form and return it to the Clerk of Court by e-mailing the same in .pdf format to the following address: consents@id.uscourts.gov. If you are a pro se litigant, you should mail this form to the following address: U.S. District Court, 550 W. Fort St. Room 400, Boise, ID 83724. The parties may submit a joint consent, similar to a stipulation, before or after receiving this Notice.

An appeal from a judgment entered by a United States Magistrate Judge will be directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of this District Court. 28 U.S.C. § 636(c); Fed.R.Civ.P. 73.
