IT HEREBY APPEARING THAT FORD MOTOR CREDIT COMPANY ("FMCC"), by and through its counsel, RICHARD J. HAYDEN and RICHARD J. HAYDEN, P.S., and Debtor, by and through Debtor's counsel, D. BLAIR CLARK and RINGERT CLARK, having stipulated to relief from stay in the event of future default and for adequate protection, and plan treatment now;

IT FURTHER HEREBY APPEARING that FMCC has moved for relief from the automatic stay because of lack of payment and on other grounds, regarding its collateral in this proceeding, specifically a 1999 FORD EXPEDITION, VIN #1FMPU18L3XLC47394, and that the parties have settled their differences, by payments Debtors will make after the motion for relief was filed, and are entering into a Stipulated Order now;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Debtor shall pay \$300.00 per month to FMCC commencing September 30, 2003. Should the Debtors become in default under this Stipulation with FMCC, the contract, note, or the security agreement, that the Debtors and their attorneys shall each receive fifteen (15)

days written notice and demand for cure by regular mail with delivery confirmation. If default is not cured on the sixteenth (16th) day, FMCC may present an ex parte order lifting the stay to the Court together with evidence of the notice of default with a three-day (3) notice of presentment of the order to counsel;

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that the event of a second default, FMCC may present an ex parte order lifting the stay to the Court together with evidence of the default with a three-day (3) notice of presentment of the order to counsel.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtors shall provide for payment in full of FMCC's claim in this proceeding, pursuant to the contract terms at state law, due to the equity position of FMCC;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtors shall provide proof of insurance within five (5) days of the entry of this order.


