NOTICE

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the trustee has filed an objection to the allowance of your claim No. 29, filed on the 27 day of August, 2003 in this bankruptcy case.

Your claim may be reduced, modified, or eliminated. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if you do not want the court to eliminate or change your claim and you wish to contest the trustee's objection to your claim, a written reply to the objection, explaining your position, must be filed in duplicate within fifteen (15) days from the date this objection is mailed. File the original (1) with the Clerk of U.S. Bankruptcy Court, (mailing address) 801 East Sherman, Pocatello, Idaho 83201 and(2) a copy with the Trustee. *If you mail your response to the court for filing, you must mail it early enough so that the court will receive it on or before the end of the (15) day period.*

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if the objection is a matter which can be corrected by filing an amended claim, you may do so prior to the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period. Failure to file a written reply will result in the Trustee requesting that the Court enter an Order disallowing the claim to the extent objected to. If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the court may decide that you do not oppose the objection to your claim and may grant the Trustee's request.


