

e. To recover and sell any repossessed property of the estate, provided the same can be sold at a profit to the estate.


3. For the foregoing and all other necessary and proper purposes, applicant desires to retain, generally, the law firm of Ringert Clark Chartered, as counsel for the trustee.

4. Because Ringert Clark Chartered, has experience in bankruptcy corporate reorganization and debtor/creditor matters, applicant feels that said law firm is well qualified to render the foregoing services.

Applicant believes that said law firm, and its members and associates, do not hold or represent any interest adverse to that of your applicant or the debtor's estate and that said law firm is a disinterested person within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. §101(13). Applicant is informed that the normal hourly billing rates of said law firm at the time of this application is \$125.00 per hour. It is contemplated that said attorneys will seek compensation based upon normal and usual hourly billing rates. It is further contemplated that said attorneys will seek interim compensation during the case as permitted by 11 U.S.C. §331.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that he be authorized to employ Ringert Clark Chartered, generally, as his attorneys to render services in the areas described above with compensation to be paid as an administrative expense in such amounts as this court may hereinafter determine and allow.
