11 3. Under the terms of the debtors' Chapter 12 Plan
12 which was confirmed by this Court on the 23rd day of February,
13 2000, the secured creditors and unsecured creditors will be
14 paid according to the terms of the debtors' Chapter 12 Plan.
15 The debtors' Chapter 12 Plan provides, among other things, that
16 the firm of Ling, Nielsen and Robinson will be paid the amount
17 allowed by the Court. Sufficient funds exist to pay the
18 attorney's fees and costs and to make the necessary payments
19 to creditors.

20 applicant received the sum of \$7,000.00. Of this sum,

22 the balance of \$5,770.00 is presently being held in a trust
23 account. That upon court approval, these funds will be applied
24 towards the attorney's fees and costs incurred herein.

26 in the sum of \$3,364.50 for time and services rendered on
