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A Motion for Termination and Annulment of the Automatic Stay has been filed by **Liberty Savings Bank, FSB**, Creditor. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the stay of actions will terminate by operation of law thirty-three (33) days after date of service by mail of this Motion pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §362 and Idaho Local Bankruptcy Rule 4001.2. In such case the stay can only be extended if the Court, after notice and hearing, which may have to be requested by you, is held before the expiration of said thirty-three (33) days and the stay is ordered extended by the Court. You are further notified that in the event no hearing is held within the thirty-three (33) days after service by mail of this motion, that the moving party may request, without further motion, an

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order from the Court declaring that the stay against actions against the above-described property has been terminated or annulled.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that any party in interest may oppose this motion by filing and serving on the undersigned a written objection thereto at least five (5) days before the preliminary hearing. The objection shall reasonably identify those matters contained in the motion that are at issue and any other basis for objection to the motion. The written objection need not be filed if the moving party sets the preliminary hearing for less than twenty (20) days after the filing of the motion, however, any opposing party must be prepared to present the information required by Idaho Local Bankruptcy Rule 309 at the preliminary hearing.

Please take notice that a hearing on the Motion will be conducted on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February 2000, at the hour of 9:30, a.m. in Room No. \_\_\_\_\_, United States Bankruptcy Court at 801 E. Sherman, Pocatello Idaho.


