**ORDER CONFIRMING SECOND
AMENDED CHAPTER 13 PLAN
AND GRANTING RELATED
MOTIONS**

18 IT HAVING BEEN DETERMINED AFTER NOTICE AND A HEARING THAT:

- 19 1. The Second Amended Chapter 13 Plan and Related Motions comply with the
20 provisions of this chapter and with other applicable provisions of this title;
- 21 2. The Second Amended Chapter 13 Plan and Related Motions has been proposed
22 in good faith and not by any means forbidden by law;
- 23 3. The value, as of the effective date of the Second Amended Chapter 13 Plan and
24 Related Motions, of property to be distributed under the plan on account of each allowed
25 unsecured claim is not less than the amount that would be paid on such claim if the estate of the
26 Debtor were liquidated under 11 U.S.C. Chapter 7 on such date;
- 27 4. With respect to each allowed secured claim provided for by the plan-
 - 28 a. the holder of such claim has accepted the plan; OR
 - b. the plan provides that (i) the holder of such claim retain the lien securing
such claim; and (ii) the value, as of the date of the effective date of the

1 plan, of property to be distributed under the plan on account of such
2 claim is not less than the *allowed secured value* of such claim.

3 5. The Debtor will be able to make all payments under the plan, and to comply with
4 the plan.

5 NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

6 A. The Second Amended Chapter 13 Plan is confirmed and Related Motions are
7 granted, incorporating the following modification:
