
TRUSTEE'S FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- (1) The Plan complies with requirements of Chapter 13. Title 11 USC.
- (2) Required fees have been paid.
- (3) Plan is proposed in good faith.
- (4) Value of property to be distributed is \$12375.00. The amount that would be paid to unsecured creditors under Chapter 7 is UNKNOWN.
- (5) Section 1325(a)(5) of the Bankruptcy Code is satisfied.
- (6) Debtor will be able to make payments and comply with the Plan.
- (7) Trustee recommendations as to Confirmation ----- Yes ----- No

MATTERS IN ISSUE:

- The debtors have not filed 1999 taxes to date.
- Washington Mutual has filed a secured mortgage default for \$2504.90 and the plan allows \$1846.00. This claim is not fully addressed.
- The debtor's have not had their self-employment meeting with their trustee to date. They did schedule the meeting 9-1-00 for Tuesday, September 12th, 2000.
- The debtors are delinquent in their Ch. 13 payments to the trustee for June and August for a total of \$550.00. Debtors attorney indicated that he would defer June payment in order.
