DISCLOSURE OF COMPENSATION - Rule 2016 (b)

1. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §329(a) and Bankruptcy Rule 2016(b), I certify that I am the attorney for the above-names debtor(s) and that compensation paid to me within one year before the filing of the petition in bankruptcy, or agreed to be paid to me, for services rendered or to be rendered on behalf of the debtor(s) in contemplation of or in connection with the bankruptcy case is \$1,685.00. The Court shall approve attorney's fees and costs in this case in the amount of \$1,685.00, \$685.00 of which has been paid up front by the debtor. The Trustee shall pay the debtor's attorney an additional \$500.00 over the first 7 months in unequal payments all of which shall be approved by the Court as fees earned up to confirmation. The Trustee shall accumulate and hold in reserves (after payment of the initial attorney's fees) the balance of the approved fees of \$1,685.00 which balance is \$500.00. Upon exparte application to the Court for additional fees accompanied by the Attorney's Affidavit of fees and costs for Post Confirmation work, the Court, in its discretion, may award additional fees and costs up to the \$500.00, held in reserve by the trustee without further notice to the creditors. In the event Attorney's fees and costs exceed \$1,685.00, the attorney shall make application to the Court with notice to all creditors and interested parties of a hearing on the matter in open Court. Reserved funds not applied to fees upon completion of the plan shall be dispersed to creditors.

2. The source of the compensation paid, or to be paid to me was the debtor(s).

3. I have not agreed to share the above-disclosed compensation with any other person unless they are members and associates of my law firm.
