COMES NOW the Chapter 7 Trustee, Richard Crawford, by and through his attorneys of record, Eberle, Berlin, Kading, Turnbow & McKlveen, Chtd., and hereby applies to the court, pursuant to § 327 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 6005, to approve employment of Thomas P. Wier, III, a medical practice appraiser, pursuant to the terms and conditions hereof. The Chapter 7 Trustee respectfully represents the following in support of his application:

1. On July 15, 1999, Debtors filed a petition under Chapter 7 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code.

2. The Chapter 7 Trustee was thereafter appointed to administer this Chapter 7 bankruptcy proceeding.

3. The Trustee requires the services of a medical practice appraiser for the following reasons:

(a) Debtors are the sole shareholders of a professional corporation known as Gary Gregerson, M.D., P.A., which professional corporation renders OBYGN services to the public (the "Professional Corporation").

(b) An appraiser is necessary to determine the value of the Professional Corporation.

(c) An appraiser is necessary to assist the Trustee in the sale of the professional corporation.

(d) An appraiser is necessary to determine if an offer for the professional organization is a fair offer.

4. The Trustee has with discussed Thomas P. Wier, III, Certified Public Accountant and Certified Valuation Analyst, 14719 Kellywood, Houston, Texas 77079, telephone (281) 531-8002 and fax (281) 531-0930, his availability to be employed as the Trustee's appraiser in this case and to perform the services required by the Trustee.

5. Thomas P. Wier, III is qualified to act as the Trustee's appraiser for the following reasons as set forth in Exhibit "A".

6. Thomas P. Wier, III and his firm are willing to accept employment by the Trustee, on the basis set forth herein. No staff member or employee of American Medical Practice Services, Inc. has any connection of any kind or nature with Debtors; nor do they

have an interest adverse to the Trustee or the bankruptcy estate in regard to the matters for which they are to be employed and he is a disinterested person within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. § 101 (14).

7. In addition, the firm and its members have no connections with the U.S. Trustee or its employees other than in their official capacity.

8. For the foregoing and all other necessary and proper purposes, the Trustee desires to retain Thomas P. Wier, III, Certified Public Accountant and Certified Valuation Analyst, as his appraiser in this case.

9. The Trustee is informed and believes that Thomas P. Wier, III, has the appropriate accounting and valuation skills and personnel needed to perform the services of providing the appraisal services required by the Trustee. He has previously been employed as an appraiser and accountant in bankruptcy matters, and, together with his staff, has extensive experience and expertise in performing this type of service. 10. Trustee is informed that the normal hourly fee of Thomas P. Wier, III, is \$250.00 per hour for his time as a CPA and Certified Valuation Analyst; staff appraiser time at the rate of \$125.00 per hour; junior accountant and clerical assistant time at the rate of \$75.00 per hour. It is contemplated that Thomas P. Wier, III will seek compensation based upon normal and usual hourly billing rates. It is further contemplated that Thomas P. Wier, III may seek interim compensation as permitted by


11 U.S.C. § 331.
