
Your claim may be reduced, modified, or eliminated. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if you do not want the Court to eliminate or change your claim and you wish to contest with the Trustee's objection to your claim, a written reply to the objection, explaining your position, must be filed in duplicate within fifteen (15) days from the date this objection is mailed. File the original (1) with the Clerk of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Federal Building, 801 E. Sherman, Pocatello, ID 83201, and (2) a copy with the Trustee. *If you mail your response to the Court for filing, you must mail it early enough so that the Court will receive it on or before the end of the fifteen (15) day period.*

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if the objection is a matter which can be corrected by filing an amended claim, you may do so prior to the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period. Failure to file a written reply will result in the Trustee requesting that the Court enter an Order disallowing the claim to the extent objected to. If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the Court may decide that you do not oppose the objection to your claim and may grant the Trustee's request.

OBJECTION
