The debtor has agreed to pay \$1406.88 from October 2002 through March 2003 which will bring their Ch. 13 payments current with the Trustee.





NOTICE

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED at the trustee of the above estate has objects to the allowance of your Claim No. 5 filed on the 5th day of July 2002.

Your claim may be reduced, modified, or eliminated. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that if you do not want the court to eliminate or change your claim and you wish to contest the Trustee's objection to your claim, a written reply to the objection, explaining your position, must be filed in duplicate within fifteen (15) days from the date this objection is mailed. File the original (1) with the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, 550 W. Fort St., MSC 042, Boise, Idaho 83724; and a copy with the Trustee. **If you mail your response to the court for filing, you must mail it early enough so that the court will receive it on or before the end of the (15 day period).**

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that if the objection is a matter which can be corrected by filing an amended claim, you may do so prior to the expiration of the fifteen (15) day period. Failure to file a written reply will result in the trustee requesting that the Court enter an order disallowing the claim to the extent objected to.

OBJECTION

- Proof of claim is alleged to be based on writing; no supporting documents attached to proof of claim; claim should be disallowed for distribution.
- Claim is a duplicate of Claim No. _____ should not be allowed for distribution.
- The lien on the personal property has been avoided; claim should be disallowed as secured

and allowed unsecured.

- No supporting documents attached to claim to show perfected security; claim should be allowed as unsecured.
- Amount of secured claim exceeds the amount allowed in the confirmed Chapter 13 plan; difference of \$_____ should be allowed as unsecured with balance to be allowed as secured.
- Proof of claim was not timely filed; last day to file claims was _____ claim should be disallowed.
- Amount of secured claim that exceeds the default as stated in the plan should be disallowed. Default only is being paid through the bankruptcy plan; ie.
- Claim is being paid directly by the debtor and should be disallowed for distribution by the bankruptcy estate.
- Collateral is being surrendered. Claim should be disallowed for distribution as filed, but may be amended to reflect deficiency.


