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of how PDG handled its share of the collections because it managed the bank account for PDG out of which PDG paid its payroll. ISC uses the remaining collections to pay the expenses of the Pocatello office, including the clerical and office staff. This motion thus will not affect payment to nonprofessional former staff of the Pocatello office.

3. Since PDG uses its entire share of the net collections as salaries it retains, to our knowledge, no assets from which ISC could collect a judgment should it prevail in this action. Indeed, I believe that PDG has threatened to go into bankruptcy at various times during this dispute and has claimed it could not afford to pay its lawyers. For this reason, rather than have PDG's share of pending accounts receivable (approximately 38 percent) paid to PDG to then be distributed to third-party defendants or otherwise wasted or concealed, ISC requests permission to pay the funds into Court pending the outcome of this action. ISC's only other option to protect its interests would simply be to withhold payment. However, to serve the interests of transparency and make clear that ISC's actions are consistent with its contractual responsibilities, if any remain upon termination of the Management Agreement, ISC would prefer to pay the funds into Court.


