Plaintiffs' counsel has stated that they will not oppose this motion.

Defendant therefore respectfully moves the Court to grant such relief as agreed upon by the parties.

The claimants' failure to cooperate with discovery has increased the costs associated with this litigation. Defendant, therefore, reserves its right to seek costs and attorney's fees, and any other sanctions as may be appropriate.


