

12 THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES:

13 On or about March 24, 1998, in the District of Idaho, defendant Ellis Royce Jackman,
14 being an employee of the Blackfoot Educators Credit Union, the accounts of which are insured
15 by the National Credit Union Administration Board, with intent to deceive an examiner of the
16 Idaho Department of Finance, knowingly made a false entry in the books of the Blackfoot
17 Educators Credit Union, in that he asked an employee to remove a \$70,000 loan from the loan
18 book, and in that he issued checks totaling \$115,633.39, to the credit union in payment for loans
19 so that the loans would appear to the examiner to have been paid, when in truth and in fact, as the
20 defendant well knew, the \$70,000 loan still existed and the defendant had insufficient funds in
21 his account to cover the \$115,633.39 check, in violation of Title 18 Section 1006.
