

Pending before the Court is the United States' Motion to Modify Conditions of Detention. The United States seeks an order prohibiting Defendant Dustin Holm from mailing letters during his incarceration. The United States alleges that Holm has sent no fewer than ten letters threatening to harm innocent civilians, federal judges and other federal employees. Having reviewed the Motion, the Court hereby orders that during the pendency of this case and while in jail, Holm is prohibited from mailing letters to anyone other than his attorney of record. It is so ordered.
