16 **INFORMATION**<sup>1</sup>  
17 (21 U.S.C. 851 - Sentence Enhancement)

18 That **AMY R. FLUCKINGER**, the defendant herein, is subject to increased punishment upon  
19 conviction for violating Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a) and (b)(1)(B), possession  
20 with intent to distribute a controlled substance by reason of his having a prior convictions for  
21 felony drug offenses which has become final, to wit; a felony conviction for trafficking marijuana  
22 in the Sixth Judicial District of the State of Idaho on January 10, 1994; a felony conviction for  
23 controlled substance possession in the Sixth Judicial District of the State of Idaho on May 20,  
24 1997; and a felony conviction for manufacturing of a controlled substance in the Sixth Judicial  
25 District of the State of Idaho on February 27, 2003.

27 <sup>1</sup> This Information is for sentencing enhancement purposes only. It does not state a  
28 separate criminal offense. It is in addition to and does **not** replace the pending charges in the  
Indictment.

1 Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 851, the United States gives notice that the  
2 prior felony drug convictions noted above subject the defendant to increased punishments upon  
3 conviction, that is, ten years to life imprisonment, as set forth in Section 841(b)(1)(B).
