New Appointment For Chief Magistrate Judge Boyle

Boise, Idaho—

The Honorable William Rehnquist, Chief Justice of the United States Supreme Court, recently reappointed Chief Magistrate Judge Larry M. Boyle to the United States Judicial Conference Committee on the Administration of the Magistrate Judges System, effective October 1, for a second, three-year term.

The Committee includes a total of twelve judges from all areas of the United States, with nine District Judges and three Magistrate Judges. Some of the duties of this committee include approving additional judgeships and making recommendations and adopting policies for the United States Court system. Chief Magistrate Judge Boyle is the Ninth Circuit's representative to the Conference.

Chief Magistrate Judge Boyle received his Juris Doctorate from the University of Idaho in 1972, and was a partner in an Idaho Falls law firm. In 1986, Judge Boyle was appointed as a district judge in the Seventh Judicial District of Idaho. In 1989, Judge Boyle was appointed a Justice of the Supreme Court of Idaho by Governor Cecil Andrus. In 1992, Judge Boyle became a United States Magistrate Judge for the District of Idaho, where he continues to serve as the Chief Magistrate Judge. Judge Boyle has also served as the Chair of the Ninth Circuit Magistrate Judge Board.
