

The Honorable Ronald E. Bush

Judge Bush will be appointed as a United States Magistrate Judge by the United States District Court for the District of Idaho, entering duty on or about September 2008.

Judge Bush is a native of Idaho and graduated high school in Idaho Falls. He received his Bachelor of Arts Degree, with honors, from the University of Idaho in 1979, and a Juris Doctorate from George Washington University School of Law in 1983. Judge Bush is currently a state district judge in the Sixth Judicial District in Pocatello. Prior to his appointment in 2003, he had been a partner in both the Boise and Pocatello offices of Hawley Troxell Ennis & Hawley.

Judge Bush participates in numerous professional and community organizations and is the past president of the Idaho Legal History Society. During his practice, he was a member of the Idaho state Bar association, American Bar Association and Shoshone Bannock Tribal Bar Association. He was one of the organizers and the first president of American Inn of Court number 130 in Boise. He has also been a lawyer representative to the U.S. District Court of Idaho and the U.S. 9th Circuit Court of Appeals Judicial Conference from 1999 to 2001.
