In addition to the duties presently carried out, the magistrate shall conduct all initial criminal arraignments and all criminal pretrial discovery proceedings. Additionally, all appeals from adverse rulings of the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare in social security matters will be referred to the magistrate. The magistrate is directed to review the matter and submit a written recommendation of proposed action. The magistrate is also authorized to hear civil discovery procedures specifically assigned by one of the judges of the court.
