

General Order 73

The objective of the plan is to attain equality before the law. The plan will be administered so those accused of a crime, or otherwise eligible for services pursuant to the C.J.A., will not be deprived if they are unable to pay for adequate representation.

The plan sets forth the circumstances for representation, as well as the duties of appointed counsel. The appendix describes the composition, administration and management of the panel of private attorneys under the plan, as well as the criminal and death penalty panel rosters.
