GENERAL ORDER NO. 375

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(f), in an emergency and upon the concurrence of the chief judges of the districts involved, a United States magistrate judge may be temporarily assigned to perform any of the duties specified in subsections (a), (b), or (c) of this section in a judicial district other than the judicial district for which he or she has been appointed.

Due to the emergency resulting from the unplanned absence of one of the Eastern District of Washington magistrate judges, the Eastern District of Washington certified the need for magistrate judge assistance from the District of Idaho.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED, with the concurrence of the Honorable Stanley A. Bastian, Chief United States District Judge of the District of Eastern Washington, that United States Chief Magistrate Judge Ronald Bush and United States Magistrate Judge Candy Dale are hereby designated to hold court and perform any and all judicial

duties designated under 28 U.S.C. § 636, subsections (a), (b), and (c), in the Eastern District of Washington, from the period of October 7, 2020, through November 6, 2020.
