

Sealed Documents Removed From CM/ECF

Because of a security breach in our national CM/ECF database, all sealed documents have been removed from the CM/ECF system. Therefore, on September 29, 2025, Chief District Judge David C. Nye entered General Order 463 which restricts electronic access to sealed documents beginning on the same date. Sealed documents will continue to be filed in CM/ECF under existing procedures and a party with the right to access a sealed document can request a paper copy by contacting the Clerk's Office. Because sealed documents filed in CM/ECF are not accessible or viewable electronically, service cannot be accomplished through CM/ECF. Parties will continue to serve sealed documents by other appropriate means as provided by the Federal Rules of Procedure. The court will serve sealed documents in paper by mail.
